



Physical Verification of Activities

I. Plantation

Methodology:- 10% plantations will be randomly selected from various divisions. The sampling intensity for evaluation will be nearly 10% for block plantations. For every hectare of plantation, the evaluation needs to be done on a 30 m. X 30 m. plot. Each plot needs to be marked on a map of plantation area, which needs to be attached with this sheet. The GPS coordinates of all such (30 m x 30 m) plots also need to be provided.

In case of linear plantation, evaluation of every 10th tree/planted sapling of each row needs to be done for 25% of its length on per running km. basis.
